Museums and galleries

Cathedrals

Mid-day: Cavern Club

Take in the atmosphere of the world famous Cavern Club, and perhaps explore the rest of Mathew Street too with its many photo stops, bars, restaurants and the Magical Beatles Museum.

Mid day: Lunch
